## Talk About it!

### QUESTION 1

#### Luke 2:8-14 New Living Translation

8 That night there were shepherds staying in the fields nearby, guarding their flocks of sheep. 9 Suddenly, an angel of the Lord appeared among them, and the radiance of the Lord's glory surrounded them. They were terrified, 10 but the angel reassured them. "Don't be afraid!" he said. "I bring you good news that will bring great joy to all people. 11 The Savior—yes, the Messiah, the Lord—has been born today in Bethlehem, the city of David! 12 And you will recognize him by this sign: You will find a baby wrapped snugly in strips of cloth, lying in a manger."

13 Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others—the armies of heaven—praising God and saying, 14 "Glory to God in highest heaven,  
and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased."

#### Discuss:

Why do you think the shepherds were afraid when they saw the angel?

Have you had an experience with the supernatural from God?

In what ways are you still waiting to experience the supernatural from God?

### QUESTION 2

#### 1 John 3:8 New Living Translation

8 But when people keep on sinning, it shows that they belong to the devil, who has been sinning since the beginning. But the Son of God came to destroy the works of the devil.

#### Discuss:

What kinds of works of the devil does Jesus destroy?

How has Jesus done this in your life? Share with the group.

### QUESTION 3

#### Luke 2:13-14 New Living Translation

13 Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others—the armies of heaven—praising God and saying, 14 "Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased."

#### Discuss:

What did the angels proclaim? Who gets the peace of God? How has this peace helped you in your life?



## QUESTION 4

### Luke 2:15-19 New Living Translation

15 When the angels had returned to heaven, the shepherds said to each other, "Let's go to Bethlehem! Let's see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about."

16 They hurried to the village and found Mary and Joseph. And there was the baby, lying in the manger. 17 After seeing him, the shepherds told everyone what had happened and what the angel had said to them about this child. 18 All who heard the shepherds' story were astonished, 19 but Mary kept all these things in her heart and thought about them often.

#### Discuss:

What did the shepherds do after the angels returned to heaven? What have you done with the good news that you've received from Jesus? What do you feel challenged to do next?

## QUESTION 5

### Luke 2:20 New Living Translation

20 The shepherds went back to their flocks, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen. It was just as the angel had told them.

What sticks out to you from this verse? Thank God for what He is showing you from this verse.
