- A. How do we see this principle of sowing and reaping at work in different areas of life (relationships, faith, generosity, etc.)?
- B. Have you ever experienced a time when generosity led to unexpected blessings?

Part 4

Luke 6:43-45

Discuss:

- A. What does this passage tell us about the connection between our hearts and our actions?
- B. How might our approach to money and giving reflect the spiritual condition of our hearts?

Part 5

Galatians 6:7-8

Discuss:

- A. What does it mean to “sow to please the Spirit”?
- B. How can we ensure we are investing in things that have eternal value?

Galatians 6:9-10

Discuss:

- A. Have you ever felt weary in doing good? How does this passage encourage you?
- B. In what ways do you feel challenged or encouraged to trust God more in your finances and daily life?
